City Administrator Report-Hillary Gintz

City Administrator Hillary Gintz had Stan Hausam contact her and ask her to ask the Aldermen to pass a mask ordinance. The Aldermen do not plan on passing a mask ordinance at this time. Administrator Gintz contacted Coltrane Asphalt to check on the square striping. They plan on

striping 10/29 weather permitting. The library has a counter that they are not needing. Helen Lamb with the Seymour Historical Society asked if the city would donate the counter to the Historic Society. The Aldermen will think about it. Utility Clerk Nicole Gonzalez cleans the Library once every two weeks. She verbally gave Administrator Gintz her resignation to no longer clean the Library. The Board agreed that the Library can start cleaning their building. Alderman William Pogue has had residents ask about the Library opening on Saturdays. A motion was made by Pogue/Ashley to change the hours of the Library to include Saturday 8-12 starting January 9, 2021. Ayes: all. Nays: none. Absent: Crisp.

Mayor's Report-Richard Vinson

Mayor Richard Vinson commented that after the last big rain the tin horns are plugged with leaves. Mayor Vinson knows this is an ongoing problem this time of year.

Aldermen Report

Alderman William Pogue said the trailer house that was tore out on North Commercial still needs to be cleaned up. Alderman Pogue read that MML has new funding available for inflow and infiltration. There is an electric line hanging really low next to the old City Hall building. Alderman Pogue had a utility pole fall in his driveway that came very close to falling on him. The pole was rotten. The city had removed all their electric off of it. They called Mediacom to remove their lines. It took Mediacom quite a while to take care of their part. When they did get there to remove their lines it was the next day that the pole fell. City Attorney Jason MacPherson said next time to send Mediacom a letter stating what date the pole needed to be cleared of their lines. This way the city has a paper trail.
