

STREET & PARK **DEPARTMENT**

PRIMARY PURPOSE

- Performs a variety of semi-skilled and skilled maintenance work.
- Operates a variety of equipment in the construction, operation and repair, maintenance and replacement of City street, alleys, drainage of right-of-way's and all city parks.

SUPERVISOR

- Under the direct supervision of the Street/Park Department Head

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

- Operates light and heavy trucks, backhoe, dump truck, compactor, mowers, and other construction equipment as assigned.
- Responsible for maintenance of equipment assigned such as greasing, checking and changing oil, etc.
- Installs traffic signs.
- Paints parking and crosswalk lines.
- Performs carpentry forming and concrete work.
- Patches holes with asphalt.
- Ensures the proper maintenance of equipment and tools by cleaning and checking equipment and tools after use.
- Maintains a variety of records as assigned.
- Utilize the proper safety precautions in all work performed.
- Ensure all playground equipment is in clean and safe condition.
- Maintain all city park grounds.
- Maintain monthly safety inspections of parks.
- Assists in all Public Works Department projects as required.

EDUCATION

- High school graduate or equivalent G.E.D.

KNOWLEDGE/EXPERIENCE

- Should exhibit abilities to follow oral and written instructions and perform required duties competently as a member of a work crew.
- Should possess knowledge of the Street department policies and procedures for installation, maintenance, and safe operation of assigned equipment.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

- Performs bending, squatting, climbing, twisting, kneeling, and reaching both to ground level and overhead.
- Lifts and carries up to one hundred (100) pounds and/or pushes and pulls up to one-hundred fifty (150) pounds.
- Holds and grips objects and subject to working in awkward positions and periods of prolonged walking, sitting, or standing.

STREET & PARK **DEPARTMENT**

WORKING ENVIRONMENT

- Primarily outdoors with exposure to dust and pollen.
- Subject to variety of extreme weather conditions.
- Susceptible to mechanical and electrical hazards associated with equipment and wiring.
- Subject to safety hazards due to traffic, animals or weather conditions.
- May be exposed to constant and extreme noise.
- Must be able to work in confined spaces.

LICENSING/CERTIFICATION

- Valid Missouri Driver's License as required for assigned vehicle.
- CDL License (if applicable)

MISCELLANEOUS REQUIREMENTS

- May be required to work weekends or subject to emergency call in.
- Subject to random drug test.
- Subject to pre-employment drug test.
- Subject to pre-employment personal/professional background check.
