The Board does not think the South Park would be able to accommodate that many people. Daniel will be on the agenda for the April 28<sup>th</sup> meeting to give an update.

#### City Administrator Report

City Administrator Hillary Gintz passed out the calendar for April. Administrator Gintz let the Board know that the transformers that were approved at the February 10, 2022 Board meeting was cancelled by the company. Harry Cooper is the only company that would let the city order transformers. They are 52-54 weeks out. The city can get rebuilt transformers quicker. Alderman Wallace said we should go ahead and get some of the rebuilt transformers ordered. Harry Cooper bid 40 transformers; the total cost is 144,205.00. The company reserves the right

to change prices at any time to cover increases in the beyond the company's control. A motion was made by Crisp/Ashley to approve the ordering of the transformers from Harry Cooper. Ayes: all. Nays: none.
